ECB CricketForce registration process

Following feedback received with regards to the registration process, changes have been made which will allow more than one person in a club to have access to and edit a club's registration and evaluation forms. A new 'CricketForce' role has been created in Play-Cricket that a person must now hold in order to complete the registration for any one club. Any number of people can have this role and so each club can now control how their CricketForce information is handled; the club's Play-Cricket administrator will have to assign the CricketForce role to the chosen club members.
